Strategic Direction

‘The provision of educational opportunities specific to the needs of Nga Potiki is underpinned by a ‘pipeline approach’ starting at early childhood to compulsory and post compulsory education leading to workforce development, in parallel with the revitalization of te reo Maori’.

Key Strategic Principles

Supporting four key principles that collectively drive the Nga Potiki education strategy aimed at simultaneously raising educational achievement and revitalizing te reo Maori:-

- Creating meaningful future's for Whanau
- Prioritising success for Whanau
- Building leadership & capacity of Whanau
- Driving innovation amongst Whanau

Kaupapa 1: Creating Exciting Futures

- Nga Potiki will increase the options for education for Maori learners and their Whānau
- Enable Whānau to access a greater range of educational opportunities
- Encourage Whānau engagement with the education system
- Undertake research to better improve Whānau participation across the education system

Kaupapa 2: Prioritise Success

- Nga Potiki will redefine success through Whānau aspirations for education and support all Maori learners to achieve best outcomes
- Identify best practice models and standards for cultural integration and immersion options
- Support professional development and learning for educators engaged in helping Maori learners.
- Identify opportunities to continue improving the quality of learning relationships between schools and Maori learners.

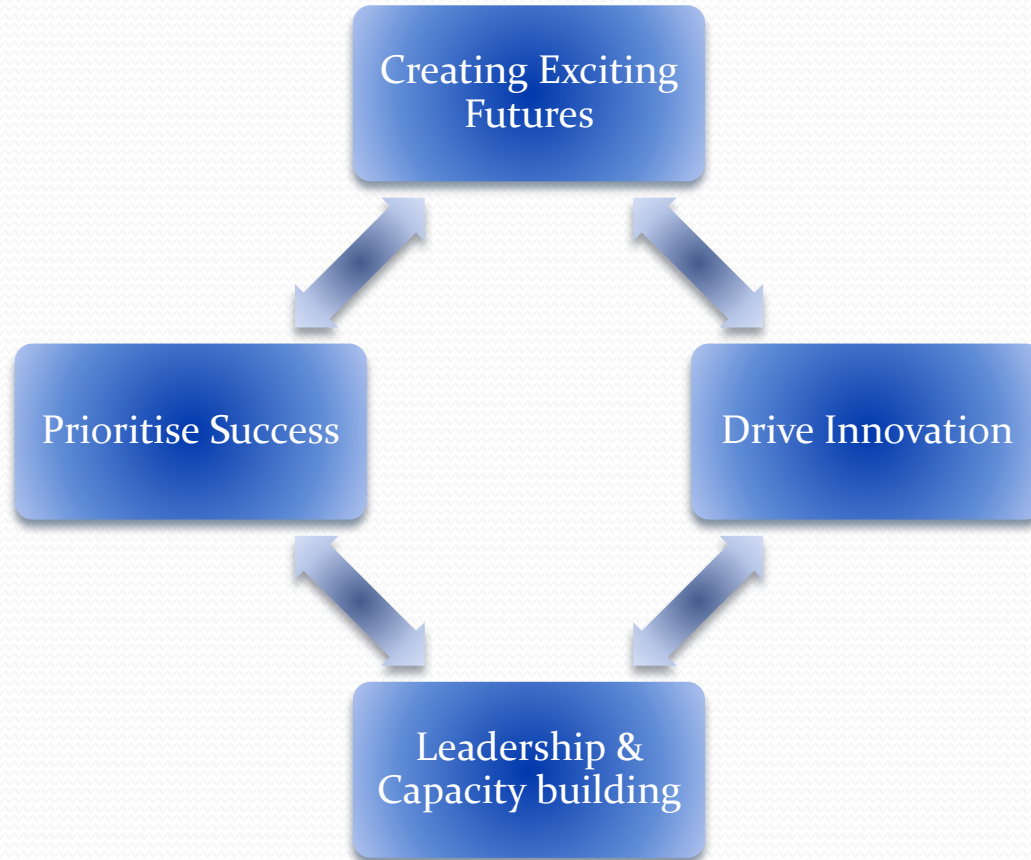
Kaupapa 3: Leadership & Capacity Building

- Nga Potiki will influence policies, programs and decision makers with respect to the delivery of education into the Nga Potiki takiwa
- Partner with and support the Crown to meet its obligations under the Treaty of Waitangi and all partnership agreements with Nga Potiki
- Actively develop relationships and where appropriate collaborate with government agencies, educational providers, NGO's and other iwi | hapu to achieve better educational outcomes for Nga Potiki whanau.
- Support the development of leadership capability in Papamoa

Kaupapa 4: Driving Innovation

- Nga Potiki will identify and actively promote innovative learning opportunities and environments for Nga Potiki and other Maori learners and their whānau
- Explore Information Technology opportunities which encourage children's learning
- Encourage the development of a culture of inquiry and problem-solving.
